An Oj ka Kavi sammelan was organized at **MAHILA PG COLLEGE, Lucknow** to remember the martyrs of the motherland.

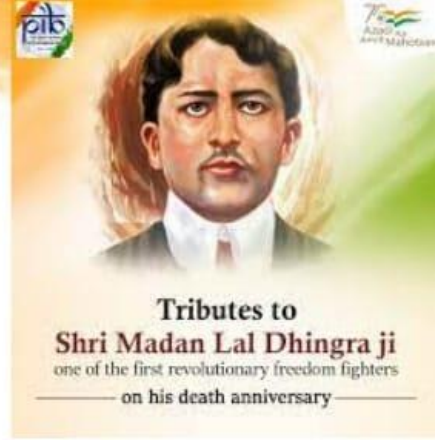

Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav is being celebrated all across the country with a lot of enthusiasm and remarkable participation by students of schools and colleges along with their teachers and gurus. During the week long celebrations 14th of August was observed as the **VIBHASHAN VIBHISHIKA SMRITI DIWAS** and to mark the day several programmes were held at the colleges across the district Lucknow.

MAHARAJA BIJLI PASI GOVERNMENT PG COLLEGE, organized a **silent march** with the tricolor to pay homage to the victims of partition, under the leadership and guidance of the Principal. This was followed by two **Documentary presentations** on the theme Azadi and the Partition of India which were watched by the students and members of the staff of the college.
