

EBSB WEBINAR "DEKHO APNA DESH": I AND II

Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat is not just a slogan but a thought that moves towards building and binding our nation in a single thread of love and compassion. Moving towards this goal, the EBSB Club of Maharaja BijliPasi Govt. P.G. College, under the able mentorship of our Principal, Prof. Manju Dikshit, and our EBSB Nodal Officer Dr Sanobar Haider, geared up for the webinars organized on 12th June, 2020 and the International Webinar "Incredible India: Yoga, Ayurveda and Spirituality" under the aegis of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat: Dekho ApnaDesh organized on 6th July, 2020 via Zoom virtual conferencing.

In the first Webinar, Our keynote speaker and chief guest, Mr. Vikramjeet Singh Rooprai, author, historian, heritage activist and educator spoke about India's heritage and the pattern of evolution with reference to Harappan and Indus Valley Civilization. He talked about the drainage system, the pottery and the stories carved on pots and seals and threw light on the practices and customs that are relevant even today.

Our distinguished speaker and guest, Mr. Ravi Bhatt, the noted historian and author, focused on the culture of Lucknow evolved by the Nawabs of Lucknow and how it has been exceptionally useful for humankind – a culture catering to the well-being of humans. He told us about the evolution of etiquettes and mannerisms of Lucknow and the secular nature of Lucknow.

In the second Webinar, Our first distinguished speaker, Dr Ram Sharma, Associate Professor and Head, Department of English, J.V.P.G. College, Baghpat, defined 'Yog' as something that 'joins'. He discussed in detail about various literary texts and vedas and quoted references from mythology to explain the importance of Yog. He also traced the history and significance of AyurvedaOur next eminent speaker, DrAbhay Narain Tiwari, Senior Ayurvedic Consultant, SachivArogya Bharat Avadhprant, discussed in detail about Ayurveda. He explained that 'Ayu' means "life" and 'Veda' means "knowledge". He elucidated that the purpose of Ayurveda is to maintain the health of a healthy man and to eradicate the disease of a diseased one. He stated that Ayurveda is the science of life.

Our subsequent distinguished speaker, Mrs. ManjriKhullar, Alternative Medicine Therapist and Pranic Healer, discussed the concept of Spirituality. She deliberated that spirituality is not any religion but a science. She went on to explain the concept through the division of human self into body, mind and soul. She reasoned that meditation is the exercise for soul and that we need to cleanse ourselves for the clarity of Divine Power and Oneness.

This was followed by our celebrated speaker from the United States of America, Prof. Carolyn Heising, Former Professor, Iowa State University, United States and Co-Founder Universal Peace Institute, Vista,

California. Prof. Heising brought to light her own personal experiences of India and how Yoga is an effective way to fight COVID-19 pandemic.


