
Analysis of the feedback highlighted the following points. It was analysed and observed that most of the faculty members answered in a positive way. As an affiliating institution, the institution has no autonomy to prepare the syllabus. It is prepared by the parent University. The institution follows the guideline of the Parent University. The faculty had a positive opinion on the syllabus was suitable to the course prescribed and was also need based, they appreciated that the syllabi had good balance between theory and application and they also stressed that there was clarity in the aims and objectives of the syllabi.

Furthermore, being governed by the State Government, enhancement of Infrastructural facility and other depends upon the Govt. and other grants. So, within limitations the authority has taken steps to upgrade the facilities depending upon the financial position of the funds and procedure.

Regarding library, some teachers propose that the library must be updated as per the latest NEP-2020 syllabus with more books, journals and subscription to E-resources, etc. Teachers, especially of the practical subjects demanded for further infrastructural and instrumental support to the laboratories.

Faculty members expressed satisfaction with the syllabus, noting that it was well-balanced between theory and practical application, with clear aims and objectives.

Most of the teachers are satisfied with the administration of the college.
